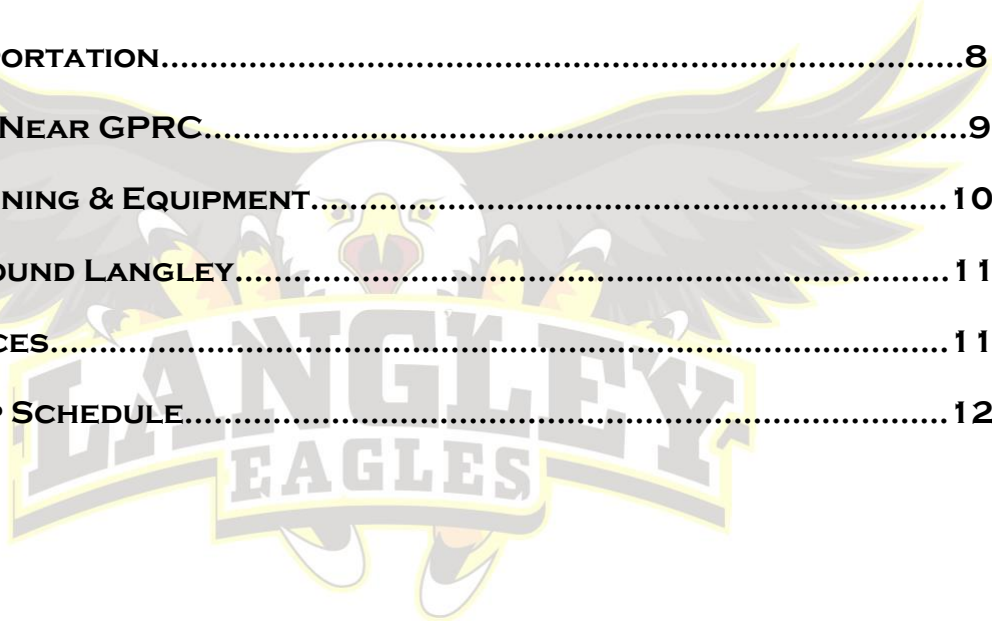

# ABOUT LANGLEY



Langley is situated in the heart of the Fraser Valley, bordered by Surrey to the west, Abbotsford to the east, Maple Ridge to the North and Washington, USA to the south. Langley, BC is unique in that it has two administrative bodies, the Township of Langley and the City of Langley.

The township of Langley, established in 1873, split administratively in 1955, when the city incorporated separately as an enclave in the western side of the township.

The Township of Langley and Langley City acknowledges that we are on the traditional territories of the ą̓w̓a:ńłəń (Kwantlen), ą̓ćəý (Katzie), Máthxwi (Matsqui) and Se'mya'me' (Semiahmoo) First Nations.



The Township of Langley was incorporated in Fort Langley in 1873 and is known as the "Birthplace of BC." A municipality unlike any other, it is a place where the rich heritage of the past is combined with a vibrant vision for the future.

The Township of Langley is home to approximately 145,000 residents (2022) in **six urban centres**, all with distinct characteristics, abundant amenities and surrounded by natural beauty and rural areas that complement an energetic urban atmosphere.

It is one of the fastest growing municipalities in Metro Vancouver with many people choosing to live here, and it is easy to see why. With a unique mix of rural and urban lifestyles and landscapes, a strong local economy, diverse housing options and numerous community services, great pride



is taken to honour the past while creating a modern, thriving, sustainable region for those who call it home today and for future generations to come.

The Township of Langley takes pride in planning for and offering world-class infrastructure, amenities, programs, and services that continue to make this municipality an exceptional place to live, work, play, learn, and do business.



The City of Langley is 10-square-kilometre urban centre located in the heart of the Lower Mainland economic region. With a population of approximately 29,000, the City of Langley offers residents all the amenities of a major urban centre — great shopping and dining, world-class education and entertainment facilities, extensive recreational opportunities and community events — plus over 346 acres of parkland!

The original settlement of Langley City was known as "Innes Corners," and was later called "Langley Prairie." The area along (Old) Yale Road developed into a major business and service centre and attracted trade from throughout the region. Continued growth resulted in the demand for higher levels of service in the community and, on March 15, 1955, the City of Langley — neighbour to the Township of Langley — was incorporated as its own separate municipality.

Today, the City's regional town centre is one of the most active industrial and service commercial land bases in the Lower Mainland. The City of Langley is well known for its distinctive retail offerings and eateries, while the surrounding area has become a magnet for high-end luxury brands and big-box retail. Offering a pedestrian-oriented Downtown Langley and a Kwantlen Polytechnic University campus located right in town, the City boasts a high-end shopping centre, independent stores, farmers' markets, terrific antique retailers and a plethora of community arts, culture and entertainment opportunities.

While the City continues to evolve, the tight-knit community and unique heritage feel remain at the forefront of our fair city's charm. With its rich history, wonderful sense of community, lush offerings of nature and proximity to Vancouver, Langley City just may be the best-kept secret in the Lower Mainland.

## FROM HIGHWAY # 1 (EAST OR WEST)

- Take 200<sup>th</sup> Street exit (Exit #58) and proceed south on 200<sup>th</sup> Street
- Turn left on 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and proceed east
- Facility and parking lot will be on the right just before 208<sup>th</sup> Street

## FROM HIGHWAY # 10 (EAST OR WEST)

- Turn right on 200<sup>th</sup> Street and proceed south
- Turn left on 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and proceed east
- Facility and parking lot will be on the right just before 208<sup>th</sup> Street

## FROM THE GOLDEN EARS BRIDGE

- Proceed south on 200 Street
- Turn left on 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and proceed east
- Facility and parking lot will be on the right just before 208<sup>th</sup> Street

## FROM WASHINGTON STATE, USA

- Enter Canada at the Pacific Highway Border crossing
- Proceed north on 176 Street, then turn right on 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue and proceed east
- Turn left on 200<sup>th</sup> Street and proceed north
- Turn right on 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and proceed east
- Facility and parking lot will be on the right just before 208<sup>th</sup> Street

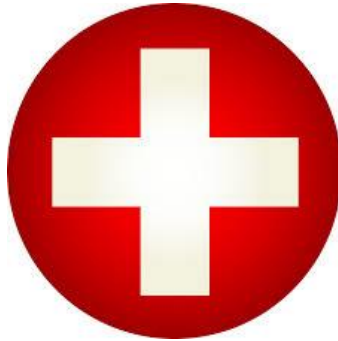
