It is the intention of this FAIR PLAY CODE OF CONDUCT to promote fair play and respect for all participants within the Association.

A parent or legal guardian MUST review this with their player(s) and must agree to this contract by stating that they will observe the principles of the Fair Play Code before being allowed to participate in hockey.

FAIR PLAY CODE:

Updated: May 2024

- I will play hockey because I want to, not because others or coaches want me to, and I will play by the rules of hockey in the true spirit of the game.
- I will control my temper fighting or "mouthing-off" can spoil the activity for everyone.
- I will respect my opponents and I will do my best to be a true team player. This includes supporting my teammates and opponents' performance.
- I will remember that winning isn't everything that having fun, improving skills, making friends, and doing my best are important.
- I will abide by the rules set by my Head Coach, accept their decisions, and show them respect. This includes following LMHA rules and policies.
- With the exception of social media posts celebrating individual and team successes, all content must be approved by the Head Coach prior to posting.
- I am aware that my coaches put together practice plans well in advance and that unexcused absences will have a negative impact on the team so regular attendance is important.
- I am aware that Hockey Canada and LMHA do not permit cell phones in the locker room with the exception of for the purpose of playing music. All other phones must be kept in a team bag/box.
