



LANGLEY CUP RULES 2019

1. This is a guaranteed two (2) game tournament. Please check the schedules posted at the rink or on the LMHA website to see who is carrying on in the tournament after each game.
 2. Teams needing to affiliate a player, please see the PCAHA Rules at the end of this document. In addition to these rules, LMHA has implemented the following that applies to the **ATOM** division:
 - In order to affiliate a player from H4, you must first provide the name to your division manager to confirm that the player is not in the top ten group of that division.
 3. Every team must have a team representative. Usually this is the team manager but if they are away please designate an alternate. It is this person's responsibility to:
 - Assign a Timekeeper if you are the **Home Team**
 - Assign a Scorekeeper if you are the **Away Team**
 4. The Home team is responsible for providing the game sheet; please give to the Visitor team at least 15-minutes before game time so they can fill in their roster. The higher seeded team is always the home team.
 5. Coaches or Managers will be required to record the name of your "Volunteer Timekeeper & Scorekeeper" on the score sheet.
 6. The referee money will be in a sealed envelope with each division manager. It is the Home team's responsibility to pick up the referee money before your game and pay the referee's at the end of the game.
 7. After your game, it is the responsibility of the Home team to give the appropriate copies of the game sheet to the two teams (pink and blue) and then drop the two League Manager copies (white and yellow) off with your Division Manager, or put them in your Division Managers mail file at GPRC. The Langley Cup Director or Division Manager will collect all the Game sheets and mail them into PCAHA. Any referee monies left over are to be returned with the game sheet copies to the Division Manager.
 8. It is the Home teams responsibility to enter the game sheet into Teamlink following the game.
 9. Teams are responsible for maintaining their dressing rooms. Coaches are responsible for ensuring that their teams leave their dressing room clean. **ABSOLUTELY NO** hockey tape left on floor, garbage, broken sticks, etc.
 10. No unsportsmanlike conduct towards the tournament Officials will be tolerated. Parents and/or Team Officials who are found to be yelling at the referees during or after a game will be asked to leave the rink immediately. This will be strictly enforced and there is a zero-tolerance policy for this behavior. Please ensure your parents spend their time cheering for their team and not complaining about calls missed or what they deem incorrect or inappropriate at the time. Coaches should send an email or speak to your team and parents as a reminder of the codes of conduct they have signed at the start of the season. If you hear any parents getting out of hand, it is a team official's responsibility to control them.
 11. Length of Periods for Langley Cup Games.
 - First period is to be 15:00 minutes long
 - Second period is to be 15:00 minutes long
 - Third period will be half the time remaining, but not less than 8:00 minutes long.
 12. Each ice slot is allocated seventy-five (75) minutes. To accommodate this time has been set for overtime as running time.
 13. Overtime will consist of a five (5) minute run time sudden death 4-on-4 period. If still tied, a three (3) man shootout; if still tied, a sudden death shootout with **new** shooters and no repeats. This is a double knock-out tournament, so there must be a winner at the end of each game.
 14. In the event of a tie at the end of overtime the following shoot-out protocol will be used:
 - Each coach will present the referee with a list of three (3) shooters by last name/number IN ORDER. The home team will have the choice to shoot first or defer to the visiting team.
 - The referee will present the scorekeeper with the list and order of shooters and each shooters result is to be recorded on the game sheet is to be recorded on the game sheet (with SO being the period code, G for goal and NG for no goal).
 - If still tied after three shooters the game will progress to a sudden death shoot-out, continuing the rotation until a winner has been determined.
 - A new shooter must take the shot each time until all dressed skaters have been utilized - **NO PLAYER CAN SHOOT TWICE**
 15. After the final game, helmets must remain on the players until they leave the ice. Insurance for all players is void if anyone removes their helmet.
- UNLESS THE TEAM HAS GONE THROUGH THE WHOLE ROSTER OF DRESSED SKATERS.**
- The following are PCAHA Rules that apply to the Langley Cup Tournament:**
16. All tournaments/jamborees held under the jurisdiction of the PCAHA shall operate under PCAHA rules and regulations in conjunction with LMHA rules and regulations.
 - 12(a) In all tournaments or jamborees, teams must consist only of those players who are included on the team roster filed with the PCAHA Executive Director (except as specifically permitted under the Affiliate Player and Goaltender Exemption rules).
 - 12(b) The tournament/jamboree director shall be entitled to verify all rosters with PCAHA Executive Director prior to the commencement of the tournament/jamboree.
 - 12(c) Any team or Association using players in a sanctioned tournament or jamboree who are not on the team's roster (except as specifically permitted under the Affiliate Player and Goaltender Exemption rules) shall be liable to disciplinary action by the PCAHA.
 17. "C" Hockey - "C" teams may draw Affiliate Players from "C" teams in lower division(s) within the same Association, subject to the following restrictions:
 - 13(a) The Affiliate Player rule shall only be applied in situations in which a team (i) has 12 or fewer skaters for a particular game or (ii) has no goaltender available for a particular game. No player may play as an Affiliate Player unless permission has first been obtained from the League Manager.
 - 13(b) When the Affiliate Player rule is utilized, a team can only apply for permission to draw Affiliate Players to a maximum of 13 skaters and 1 goaltender.
