

VISITING TEAMS: LMHA GAME PLAY PROTOCOL

- Visiting team Players / Officials must complete our [LMHA Event Health Screening Form](#) on the day of the event, at least one hour prior to arriving.
- Attendees must be prepared to present their Health Screening form (will be emailed to you upon completion) to the LMHA HCSP and/or Team Manager for verification and clearance. Your Team Manager/HCSP can coordinate this with the home team.
- Players will enter the arena as dressed as possible and go directly to their assigned dressing room.
- Players will wear masks in and out of the arena and in the dressing room, other than when they are wearing helmets.
- Players will enter the arena no more than fifteen (15) minutes prior to their ice time. They will wait in their vehicle or line up outside the rink if they arrive early.
- Please ensure you maintain social distancing at all times and are wearing a mask.
- Parents are NOT permitted in the arena/facility in order to keep our number in compliance with the current facility restrictions. This includes the lobby area. NO congregating, tailgating or otherwise will be permitted in the parking lot.
- Two (2) Coaches per team are permitted in the arena and on the bench. They must WEAR MASKS at all times, including on the bench during game play.
- Two (2) HCSP's per team are permitted in the arena who must wear masks at all times. Please note that the HCSP is NOT permitted on the bench during game play unless needed to attend to a player.
- One (1) scorekeeper and one (1) timekeeper in the arena per game, who must wear masks at all times (cannot be the HCSP) – these roles will be supplied by the home team.
- One (1) dressing room per team under Phase 3 game play protocol. Players are required to wear masks **at all times** until their helmet is on and heading to the ice. Upon return to the dressing room, when the helmet comes off, the masks must go back on.
- Games are 5 v 5 during Phase 3 gameplay.
- No handshake at the end of the game will occur.
- No spitting is permitted in the arena, dressing room, on the ice or anywhere.
- After the game is over, teams have up to fifteen (15) minutes to vacate the building. All attendees will exit via the side doors – Rink 1 & 2 will exit off Rink 1 and Rink 3 & 4 will exit off of Rink 4 (by the former Captain Kids).
- Showers are off limits at this time.
